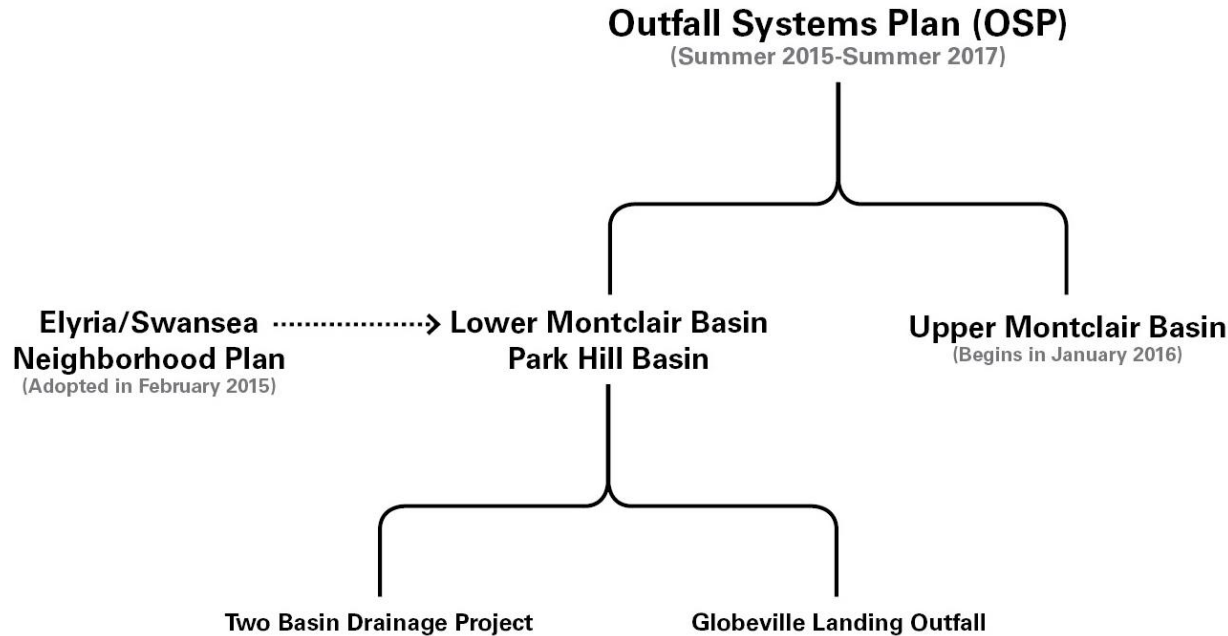


What is the Outfall Systems Plan?



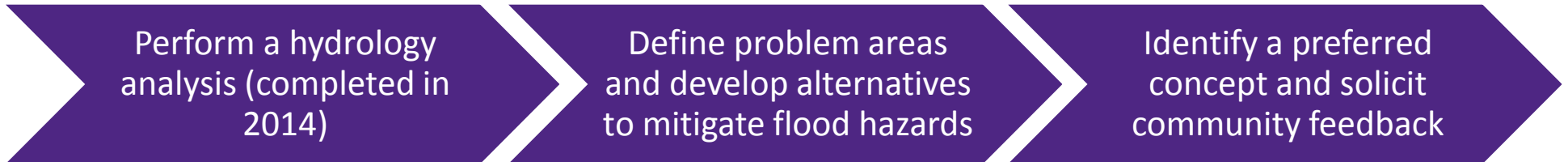
The Urban Drainage and Flood Control District and the City and County of Denver are creating an Outfall Systems Plan designed to examine current flooding problem areas from Fairmont Cemetery to the South Platte River along I-70.

This 9 square mile watershed study area will develop alternatives to address flooding in both the lower and upper Montclair Basin and identify opportunities for storm water detention and water quality.

When complete, this 12 to 18 month planning process will result in incremental improvements over the next 30 years that provide major 100-year outfall solutions.

Platte to Park Hill: Stormwater Systems is a project within the broader OSP that focuses on the Lower Montclair Basin (North of 17th St to I-70).
